WHY CONSIDER ENERGY INTERNSHIPS AND APPRENTICESHIPS (AND HOW TO FIND THEM!)

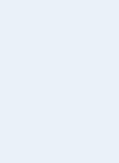

FINDING YOUR FUTURE IN THE INNOVATIVE, IMAGINATIVE ENERGY INDUSTRY

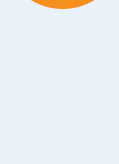
